There are several ways to import styles from other drawings:

Method 1: From toolspace

Open both drawings and navigate to **Toolspace** > **Settings**. Select the drawing where you want to apply the styles (the target drawing). Then, drag the settings from the source drawing into the target drawing.

Method 2: Using command line to pull style from another drawing

Use the **_AttachReferenceTemplate** command to import styles from another drawing.
